

# Sigma Phi Epsilon Incoming Freshmen Suggested Move-in Items 2013-2014



## What's provided in your room

- Twin bed frames and mattresses
- Shared Lockers and/or closet space
- Chairs at each desk space
- Drawer space
- High-speed wireless internet connection

#### What to bring

- Your NCard (NU ID)
- Twin-size sheets (most mattresses are 36" by 75")
- Bedspread or comforter, blankets
- Pillow and pillowcases
- Alarm clock or clock-radio with battery (or cell phone alarm)
- Towels and washcloths
- Shower tote/caddy/robe/shower shoes
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc)
- Clotheshangers
- Backpack
- Season-appropriate clothing (switch clothes out during breaks)
- Umbrella
- Surge protectors
- Social Security Card (for employment purposes)
- Insurance and pharmacy cards
- Prescription refills
- Current prescription medications, in their original containers
- Information: physicians' name, address, telephone number, emergency telephone numbers
- Laundry detergent (regular detergent is fine, washers are not HE)

#### **Optional items to consider:**

- Laundry basket
- Cleaning supplies
- Personal computer/lpad/etc
- Checkbook/ debit card
- 3M adhesive materials for walls (nails are not permitted)
- Televisions/ videogame consoles
- Microwave (a microwave is available 24/7 in the kitchen-area)
- Lamps
- Furniture (please be mindful that freshmen move 3 different times during the 1<sup>st</sup> semester to build brotherhood. Bringing additional furniture can be a fire hazard when there is too much in one room)

### What you should NOT Bring

- Candles
- Extension cords
- Toaster ovens, skillets, grills, etc (the kitchen has these items available)
- Space heaters

# Items in room that are illegal or subject to automatic expulsion from the house

- Alcohol, illegal drugs and/or prescription drugs that do not belong to the possessor
- Weapons or ammunition (firearms, martial arts weapons, knives, paint ball guns)
- Pets
- Fireworks / or other explosives
