Sigma Phi Epsilon and the Sigma Phi Epsilon Foundation in Nebraska are non-profit organizations dedicated to enriching the undergraduate experience of our members at the University of Nebraska – Lincoln. The SigEp experience is very valuable, but the facility, food and programming represent significant expenses. Therefore, it is critically important that members and/or members' parents fulfill their financial obligations in a timely manner. Every dollar unpaid by a member, must be funded by other brothers both now and in the future.

This document outlines a member's financial obligations and payment options. Please note that SigEp **DOES NOT SEND INVOICES.** This document is the only reminder of the financial obligations outlined in the Member and Lease Agreements.

2015/2016 Fee Schedule

Members living in the chapter house: \$9,078 per year (\$4,539 per semester)
Members not living in the chapter house: \$1,878 per year (\$939 per semester)

Please note that fees this year include a Philanthropy Charge of \$40/semester approved by the Undergraduate Chapter. Members may recoup this fee by selling tickets to a philanthropic event each semester.

2015/2016 Payment Options

1. Pay 100% of Semester Fees by check before the first day of class each semester and receive a discount of \$100 (Live-in) and \$50 (Live-out)
 - \$4,439 - Live-in
 - \$ 889 - Live-out
2. Payments will be automatically drafted from a member specified bank account in three equal installments per semester
 - \$1,513 (Live-in) or \$313 (Live-out) on August 24, October 1, November 1, January 11, February 1 & March 1

Officer & Other Positions' House Bill Discounts

- President 25%
- VP Finance 25%
- VP Recruitment 60%
- Recruitment Chairmen 55%
- VP Member Development 10%
- House Manager 50%
- Hasher 33%

Hasher discount is applied during the semester worked.

Officers and House Manager are elected in November each year. Discounts are applied during the full academic year following election (e.g. Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 for Officers and House Manager elected in November 2015).

Late Payment Fees

- Returned Check Fee: \$50
- 30 Days Past Due: 10%
- 60 Days Past Due: 20%

One Time Fees for New Members – Paid Upon Joining

Damage Deposit: \$300 (Refundable, less any outstanding fees, upon attaining Alumni status)
Capital Improvement Fund: \$200
Lifetime Membership Fee: \$275
